Fees Schedule 2011-2012

Application Fee

Fee assessed and due during the application and admissions process.

Pre-Kindergarten – \$50 - A per student fee submitted with the completed admissions application.

Kindergarten – 12th – \$100 - A per student fee submitted with the completed admissions application.

Registration Fees

Fees assessed and due during the enrollment or reenrollment process.

Registration Fee - \$150 - Charged annually and payable at enrollment. Families reenrolling their children at WCCS are eligible for a \$50 registration fee discount if reenrollment is completed by February 18, 2011.

FACTS Enrollment Fee - Annual per family fee paid directly to FACTS Tuition Management for those choosing to draft tuition monthly or in two installments. The annual fee for monthly draft election is \$41. The annual fee for two installment draft election is \$10. This fee is drafted at the time enrollment is processed by FACTS.

Facility Assessment Fee - \$225 – A per family fee charged annually to provide funds for current and future facility improvement and repair projects. Note: any family with children only enrolled in a part-time pre-kindergarten program is eligible for a \$100 credit for this fee.

Athletic Fee - \$75 - A \$75 per student per sport athletic fee will be assessed for each student participating in a WCCS organized sport. This fee is payable when final rosters are established and is used to offset a portion of total athletic operating expenses. An additional \$75 equipment charge will be assessed for those students participating in the Jr. High or Varsity Football programs.

Miscellaneous Fees

Extended School Care (ESC) - An optional service available to families who need before or after school supervision for their children. Programs and fees are detailed in a separate brochure.

Student Talent and Academic Recovery (STAR) – A supplemental service available to assist the special needs of students with learning differences and exceptionalities. Programs and fees are detailed in a separate brochure.

Lunch - WCCS provides a full-service food program for both Westminster and Catawba Campuses. Programs and fees are detailed in a separate brochure.

Activity Fees

4 yr Pre-K – 4th Grade - A \$50 per child fee covers the cost of all field trips and extra activity expenses for the school year. This fee also includes a class T-shirt for each student.

5th Grade – A \$150 per child fee covers the cost of the Camp Thunderbird trip, extra activity expenses, and a class T-shirt. The three day, two night Camp Thunderbird trip occurs in the fall at the Environmental Education Center at Camp Thunderbird on Lake Wylie. This hands-on experience reinforces and enhances the science curriculum with interactive activities including forest ecology and Native American and Pioneer studies.

6th Grade – A \$460 per child fee covers the cost of the Outer Banks trip, the Asheboro Zoo trip, extra activity expenses and a class T-shirt. The three-day Outer Banks trip occurs in the late spring. During this trip, students visit Fort Macon, Shackleford Banks, Ocracoke, the Cape Hatteras lighthouse, Jockeys Ridge (the largest natural, living sand dune on the East Coast), the Wright Brothers Memorial, and Roanoke Island Festival Park. Both sixth grade trips reinforce and enhance the science and social studies curriculum.

7th Grade – A \$70 per child fee covers the cost of the class team building activity, extra activity expenses and a class field day T-shirt. The class team building activity occurs in the fall at the beginning of the school year. This off-site day trip cultivates team building skills, develops group problem solving skills and fosters class unity in a natural outdoor environment.

8th Grade – A \$360 per child fee covers the cost of the Charleston trip, extra activity expenses and a class field day T-shirt. The three-day, two-night spring Charleston trip strengthens the South Carolina History curriculum. Experiences may include visits to the U.S.S. Hunley, the Charleston Tea Plantation, Fort Sumter and the state aquarium. The trip concludes with a visit to the state Capitol in Columbia.

9th Grade – A \$75 per child fee covers the cost of the class team building activity, extra activity expenses and a class field day T-shirt. The class team building activity occurs in the fall at the beginning of the school year. This off-site day trip cultivates team building skills, develops group problem solving skills and fosters class unity in a natural outdoor environment.

10th Grade – A \$450 per child fee covers the cost of the Washington, DC trip, extra activity expenses and a class field day T-shirt. The four-day, three-night spring Washington, DC trip enhances the World and American History curricula and the American Literature curriculum. Points of interest on this trip may include the Smithsonian and Holocaust Museums, the Library of Congress, the U.S. Capitol, and many of the monuments and memorials.

11th Grade – A \$50 per child fee covers the cost of extra activity expenses and a class field day T-shirt.

12th Grade – A \$200 per child fee covers the cost of class dues, extra activity expenses and a class field day T-shirt.

The above activity fees do not cover the cost of required school supplies, personal athletic equipment or class specific expenses disclosed in the course syllabi.
