## CLASS RANK

Students are officially ranked at the end of their sophomore year. Students ranked in the top 6% at the conclusion of their sophomore, junior, or senior year may be eligible for the SC Palmetto Fellows Scholarship based on their cumulative GPA and standardized test scores. ## COMMUNITY SERVICE

Community service is a key emphasis of our high school program. Seniors must have 60 hours of accumulated community service in order to graduate. The 18 graduates of the WCCS Class of 2020 accumulated over 2,000 hours of community service during their high school years.
