

Barnes Scholarship Information

The Barnes Scholarship is a \$2,000 tuition-assistance scholarship that is awarded to two rising 7th-12th grade students. The applicant must be a U.S. citizen, must be a new or returning full-time student at WCCS, must have demonstrated leadership potential and good moral character, and must need financial assistance. This is determined by completing the Variable Tuition/FACTS Financial Assistance Application, which **must be completed by March 2, 2018.** This application can be found on the www.wccs.org website, under the Admissions tab and Variable Tuition. Please note there is a fee per family to complete this application.

Scholarship Submission deadline is March 28, 2018 (Please submit to the Upper School Principal's office).

The scholarship recipient will be chosen by a majority vote of the *Scholarship Selection Committee*, which will be comprised of the secondary principal, business manager, and both a middle and high school teacher selected by the principal. The recipients will be announced at the May awards ceremony on, May 7, 2018, at Westminster Hall. The award will be applied to the recipient's 2018-2019 tuition at WCCS.
