I have sought out WCCS as the school for my child(ren) believing that the faculty/staff/administration and I can partner together in the Christian education/training of my child(ren), guiding them in the ways of the Lord as is done at home. To that end...

I pledge to support the mission of WCCS.

Mission: As a ministry of Westminster Presbyterian Church, Westminster Catawba Christian School exists to educate students to bless our world as disciples of Jesus Christ.

I pledge to be a good partner with the faculty/staff/administration/board of the school and will do whatever I can to support, encourage, and honor them both publically and privately; intentionally committing to be in prayer for them throughout the school year.

I pledge to honor my financial commitments to the school in a timely fashion.

I pledge to support the policies and procedures of the school as written in the Parent Student Handbook.

In obedience to the Word of God, I do commit myself to the goal of giving a good report. If this is not possible, I do purpose to remain silent and go privately to the person and explain what hinders me from giving a good report. I hereby purpose to approach any offender in a spirit of genuine love, having first examined and corrected my own attitudes and actions. Only if I am unable to restore the offender will I share the problem with others, and then only in accordance of Matthew 18:15-18. If I violate this vow, I purpose to ask forgiveness and pursue reconciliation, knowing that God resists the proud but gives grace to the humble.

I am in agreement with the statements of faith listed below:

- We believe in the Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments as inspired by God, inerrant in the original writings, and the supreme authority for faith and life.
- We believe in one God existing in three persons: Father, Son and Holy Spirit, co-equal and eternal.
- We believe that man was created by God and bears His image, that he sinned against God's law and thereby incurred physical and spiritual death.
- We believe that all human beings are born with a sinful nature and are in need of the Savior Jesus Christ for God's reconciliation with them.
- We believe that Jesus Christ was begotten by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, and is the one true God.
- We believe that Jesus Christ died for the sins of His people, according to the Scriptures, as a voluntary representative and substitutionary sacrifice.

- We believe in the resurrection of the crucified body of Jesus Christ, in His ascension into Heaven, and His personal and visible return to this earth.
- We believe that all who receive by faith the Lord Jesus Christ are born again of the Holy Spirit; become children of God; are indwelt by the Holy Spirit; progressively become more Christ-like in thought, word, and action; and are eternally secure.
- We believe in the bodily resurrection of all persons, judgment to come, the everlasting blessedness of the saved, and the everlasting punishment of the lost.
